This fortune-telling method is credited to Egyptian fortune-tellers, & answers those who seek to know their romantic future. Remove the tens (they're considered unlucky in this instance) & the jokers (for love is no joke). Shuffle the deck, & choose a card from the face-down pack. Turn the card over, then look for the corresponding rhyme.

Beyond dark clouds are blue, blue skies.*

Two of Clubs:

*The Priest of Isis scans your fate –
Your true love waits at the old church gate.*

Two of Spades:

*Though sorrow comes in with parting pain,
He shall come back to you again.*

Three of Diamonds:

*Three words of love in a garden fair –
He shall be waiting for you there.*

Three of Hearts:

*The third hour of the third day,
The King of Hearts shall win you away.*

Three of Clubs:

*Wealth, good health, & a lover true,
These are the three in store for you.*

Three of Spades:

*Ruler of his heart you'll ever reign,
If you should meet him on a train.*

Four of Diamonds:

*Under your pillow, place a rose,
For luck to your lover wherever he goes.*

Four of Hearts:

*As you sit in the firelight's glow,
His name is written in the embers low.*

Four of Clubs:

*A gypsy woman will tell you the truth –
You are fated to marry the love of your youth.*

Four of Spades:

*A letter written in purple ink,
Will bring you more than you can think..*

Five of Diamonds:

*If a large black cat you see,
'Twill bring good luck 'twixt one and three.*

Five of Hearts:

*Five this week is your lucky number,
And fortune comes to you in slumber.*

Five of Clubs:

*If, when the moon is full, you kiss,
It will lead to married bliss.*

Five of Spades:

*On a summer's day, by the deep blue sea,
You'll have luck if you count to fifty-three.*

Six of Diamonds:

*If you would be a rich man's wife,
Cut a silk cord with a silver knife.*

Six of Hearts:

*If a blue butterfly you see,
It is your luck to go over the sea.*

Six of Clubs:

*The Six of Clubs will bring you hope.
Make three knots in a piece of rope.*

Six of Spades:

*His heart is gold, his eyes are grey,
You'll meet him on a Saturday.*

Seven of Diamonds:

*Three men, three men in love with you.
The first and last will never be true.*

Seven of Hearts:

*On a Tuesday you may look to find,
A lover who is true and kind.*

Seven of Clubs:

*His words are fair, his heart is black,
So turn to one whose name is Jack.*

Seven of Spades:

*Your lucky color is apple green,
And your lucky number, twice fourteen.*

Eight of Diamonds:

*Should you doubt his love for you,
Place a golden bead in your left shoe.*

Eight of Hearts:

*A twilight kiss and a dream of bliss –
A little black dog will lead you to this.*

Eight of Clubs:

You will have luck when you meet in the snow.*

Eight of Spades:

Nine of Diamonds:

Nine of Hearts:

Nine of Clubs:
