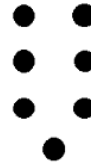


Geomancy Symbols in the Twelve Houses

Euphonia Carstairs

Symbol: Tristitia



House:	Meaning:
1	This symbol denotes a short life for the subject, and not otherwise. Much vexation, sorrow and disappointment will the subject suffer. The mind is both melancholy and misanthropic, brooding and taciturn.
2	The Acquisitiveness impulse is strong. Money will be acquired by slow, penurious methods. Losses will occur through forgetfulness, displacement, and lack of initiative. The stolen goods will not be returned.
3	Relatives are few. The subject will outlive his kindred. His short-distance journeys will be unfortunate. The expected letter will be delayed.
4	The house will prove unfortunate. Mining and real estate investments will cause losses.
5	Children are denied to the subject. Love affairs will prove unfortunate. Speculations will cause trouble and loss. There is no patrimony or inheritance to be had.
6	The health is afflicted. Servants/employees are a source of annoyance and trouble, yet difficult to get rid of. The occupation is not profitable.
7	Marriage is delayed. The spouse is of a sickly nature. Contracts are fulfilled only after a delay, and generally show a loss. The opponent is not likely to succeed, except he takes much time to do so.
8	Death is the result of a protracted illness. There will be no dowry. Legacies, if any, will be the occasion for trouble for the subject.

House:	Meaning:
9	The dream is unfortunate, denoting grief and loss. The long-distance trip will not be successful, and may prove dangerous. Publication will prove successful, but only after a long time. The lawyer will cause disappointment.
10	The credit will be secure, but not large. The position, steady. The preferment will not be obtained. The subject will be powerful, but unpopular.

Symbol: Carcer



1	A short life is indicated. A cramped and impoverished nature; selfish and taciturn.
2	Much poverty for the subject. The property will be lost, or hidden away. Goods will be confiscated or seized. Anything lost will be locked away.
3	There will be restraint and even hatred among relations. The short-distance journey will be very unfortunate. The expected letter, or letters, will be lost or detained.
4	The house will be distrained-upon. No value attaches to the estate. Minerals cannot be worked. The end of life will be in an asylum or other place of detention. There will be dissension between the subject and their parents.
5	Either the subject will have no children, or those born will be very unfortunate. Speculations will prove disastrous, and may leave the person penniless.
6	The sickness will be enduring. Servants/employees will cause loss. Creature comforts will be difficult to obtain. The occupation will be sedentary or much-confined.

House:	Meaning:
7	There is no love between the partners in marriage. Contracts are broken. The opponent will be either withheld or rendered powerless.
8	The spouse will have no dowry, or it will be tied-up in trust or chancery. Death takes place either obscurely, or by violence and in solitude. There will be no legacy.
9	Exile. The traveler will not return. The long-distance voyage will not be fortunate, and the ship may be stranded. The dream is very unfortunate, and denotes privation and suffering. Legal affairs cause loss. Publications will be quite unsuccessful.
10	A bad master. No position, credit or esteem for the subject. Separation or estrangement from parents is indicated.

12	The prisoner will be freed. The exile is in danger. The confinement will be both hazardous and painful. The distress will be increased with loss.

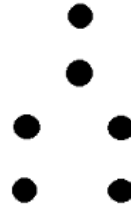
Symbol: Fortuna Major

12	The prisoner will continue in custody. The exile will not return. Enemies are numerous, but of low-degree. The confinement will hardly be fortunate, and will be protracted.

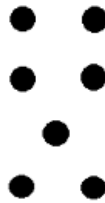
Symbol: Amissio

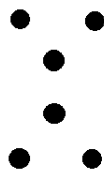
Symbol: Albus



House:	Meaning:
1	This symbol and house indicates a sprightly, active and intelligent person, who is both talkative and a busybody. This symbol and house position also indicates the danger of an accident. The individual is sharp-witted and cunning.

2	The subject will gain by the sharp use of their faculties, but they are in danger of using spurious methods to attain their ends. The lost goods will not be found or returned. The financial prospects for this person are hazardous, and chiefly associated with litigation.
3	The subject's relatives will be inimical to them. The short-distance journey under consideration will have its dangers, but nonetheless will be fairly successful. The coming letter proposes either a meeting or an understanding.
4	The parent indicated is of low-degree, and will have a short life. The house is unfortunate. Mining prospects are hardly good, bringing disputes and anxiety. The end of life will be full of small troubles and anxieties.
5	The child will be a girl. The subject's progeny will be few, but well-equipped and highly-fortunate. Speculations are not profitable. There will be no inheritance. Love affairs will cause anxiety.

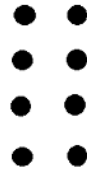
Symbol: Via

12	The exile will return. The prisoner will escape. The confinement will be over quickly. The enemy is a dark, slender woman. The restraint is put into effect.

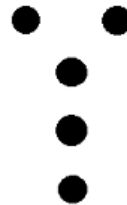
Symbol: Populus

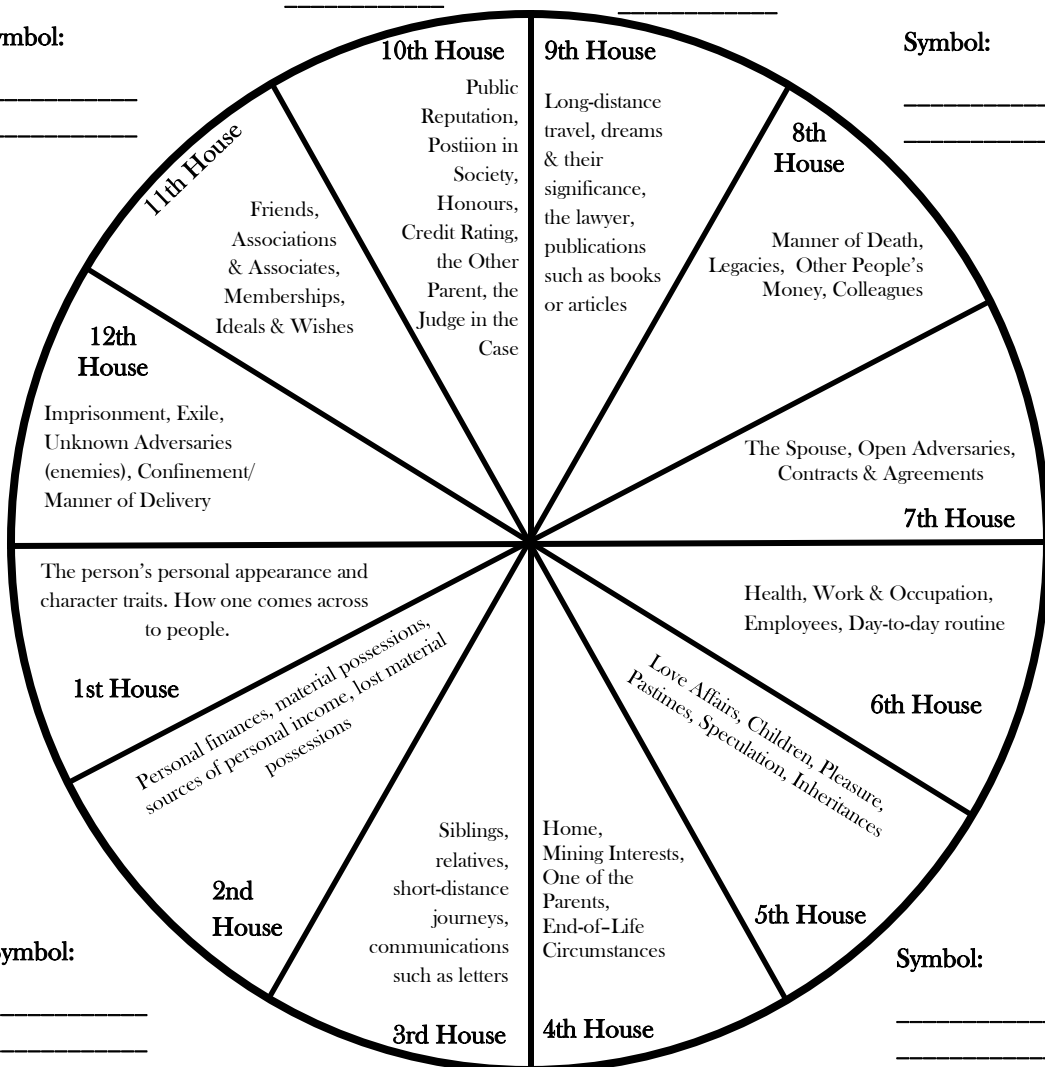
