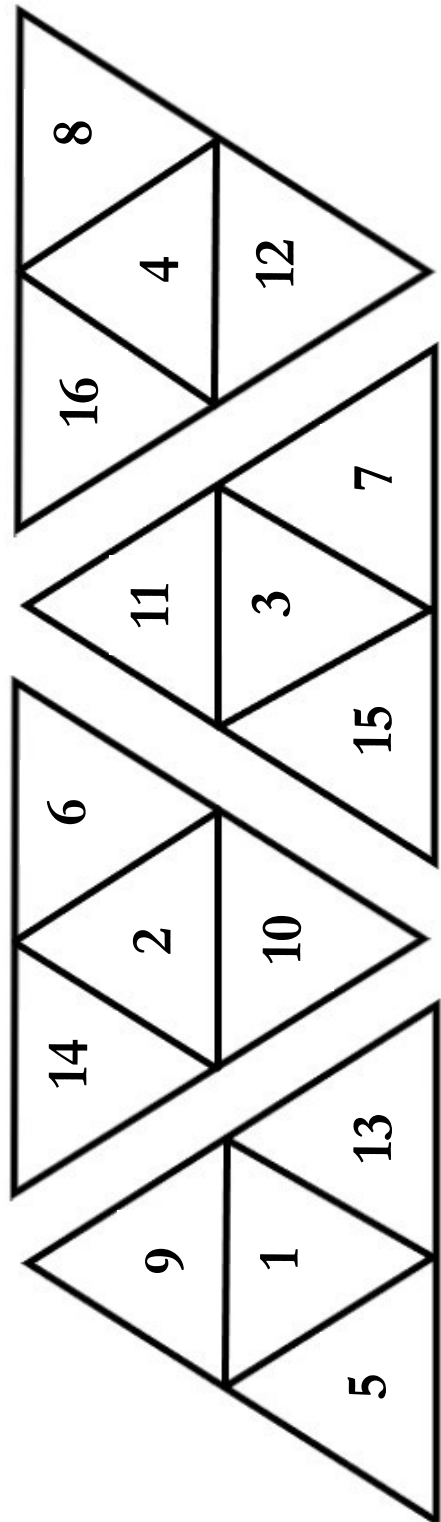


TABLET OF THE SIXTEEN PYRAMIDS



For Questions Concerning wise advice for the near-future.

To be consulted no more than once every 37 days

RULES:

The inquirer should hold the pointer, tip-down, over the chart with their eyes closed, while another person rotates the chart below the pointer-tip five times. Eyes still closed, the inquirer then brings the pointer down on the chart and reads the number of their fortune. If they have missed landing on any of the pyramids, they may try again, but the inquirer is permitted three attempts total. If in three tries, they have not landed on a pyramid, they must wait twenty-four hours before trying again. If they still fail to obtain an answer in three attempts, they must wait 37 days before trying again.

ANSWER KEY TO THE SIXTEEN PYRAMIDS

1. Trust in your hunch; it is good.
2. Beware the advice of a well-meaning friend; it is not as sound as they think it is.
3. If you are planning to pursue some course of action, delay it for a few days.
4. Seek advice before you proceed with your project.
5. You should think over your recent actions carefully.
6. Do not let yourself be tempted into taking a hasty step.
7. You must apologize or make amends for an unfriendly word you have uttered.
8. An unpleasant duty lies ahead of you; do not shirk it.
9. Beware of unexpected benefits. They may also bring unexpected sorrow.
10. From an enemy, you are going to learn something which will be to your potential advantage.
11. Let no one divert you from your present purpose.
12. You are in danger of neglecting an important duty.
13. Abandon you present schemes, or you will meet with failure.
14. A dark cloud will bring great joy.
15. Fear will beset you soon. Conquer it.
16. You are going to offend a friend if you continue with your present plans.
