

# An Universal Oracle Deck

## Giving Answers to All Questions

...Provided all such questions for which the Inquirer seeks an answer fall within the categories of 'yes', 'no' or 'maybe.'

### How to Use This Deck

Separate the cards of this deck into two packs, one pack containing the questions, a second pack containing the answer cards.

The pack containing the questions is handed to the Inquirer, who selects one, then hands it back to the Diviner. The Diviner shuffles the answer pack, fans it out, face-down and proffers it to the Inquirer, directing them to choose one. The selected card is then turned over and read.

**Alternative Method:** For added amusement, if there is more than one Inquirer, have each choose a question card, then the Diviner shuffles and deals out the answer cards at random to each Inquirer, as if in a regular card game.

Answer No. 1:


Your wishes in that

circumstances.


The Oracle's

your own.




The Oracle's

I think not.




The Oracle's
