

Introduction:

Greetings! May this chart bring you many fun hours of intrigue, inspiration and hope! It is designed for those curious individuals who want to know who they'll marry, who their next love will be, or even who their next friend will be. Though I cannot guarantee what it tells you will come true, if used with true, sincere intent, it should give you answers of some accuracy.

The center wheel is based on *The Art of Nameology* by Norma J. Watts. Each letter carries with it certain personality traits, so as the spinner is spelling out the name or initials of your mystery person, it is also giving you clues about this person's character.

You may ask it for the person's initials, their first name, last name, middle name or even nick-name!

The upper-left-corner wheel is the eye-color chart, should you want to know the color of this person's eyes. It has most of the common eye colors, but not necessarily all of them. If the spinner lands on the mixed-color eye on the right-side of the wheel, assume their eye color is variegated, or some unusual color. If it wobbles or lands between two eye colors, assume their eyes are some combination of both.

The upper-right-corner wheel is hair color. It has the most-common hair colors, but not all. If the spinner wobbles or lands between two hair colors, then either their hair is some combination of both, or they may've been one hair color, then gradually changed into the other! If the spinner lands on the colorfully-hirsute head in the lower right sector of this chart, assume your mystery-person's hair is, or includes, a color not normally found in nature.

The lower-left-corner wheel is the general job categories wheel, if you want to know roughly in what line of work they are. You *might* also be able to employ this chart in order to get some idea of where you're going to meet them!

The lower-right-wheel is the religions chart, if you want to know what their fundamental spiritual orientation is. Depending on whether you are asking about a future spouse, lover, or platonic friend, and what your own spiritual orientation is, this may be a factor you will wish to know.

To Use:

1.) You need some object which will spin. A toy spinning-top or a gyroscope is *ideal* for this purpose, although if you can get it to spin, a coin may be used as well. In a pinch, even a small, super-bouncy ball can be used if you can put a spin on it! **2.) Make sure the surface on which you place the gyromancy chart is as level as possible.** Even a slightly-angled surface will affect the answers you receive. **3.) Cup your spinning-object in both hands, prayer-fashion, and ask Whomever you ask before divining – Deity/Deities, Ancestors, Spirit Guides, Angels, or your own Higher Self to guide this spinner in its course, and to give you true answers to your questions.** *This step is important, because They are going to be controlling it!* This form of gyromancy is a bit similar to using the Ouija board, minus the hands-on part. You don't want a mischievous or malignant spirit commandeering your spinner! **4.) Place the spinner, dead-center in whatever wheel you wish to use, then give it as good a spin as you can.** This may take some practice, and you will probably have to do it a number of times before this session is over. I recommend using your less-dominant hand for the spin, because that's your *receiving* hand. I find it gives me a more honest answer, but use whatever hand feels right to you. **5.) Record the spinner's path on the chart.** You may use your phone, or even the old-fashioned paper & pen or pencil, but record it. Did it pause anywhere? Did it pause on a line? Did it hit several sectors, or stay in one place? Where did the spinner land? Did it end up pointing to anything in particular?

Final Thoughts:

If you perform gyromancy of this sort with regularity, you may want to have a special top or gyroscope kept just for this purpose. This gradually empowers/entrains the spinner to function specifically as a divinatory tool, not as a toy. Along with blessing the spinner before use, you may also want to ask your chosen Higher Power to bless the chart as well. Consider the answers you received. If you could sum it up as a sentence or paragraph, how would it read? Finally, have fun with it!
