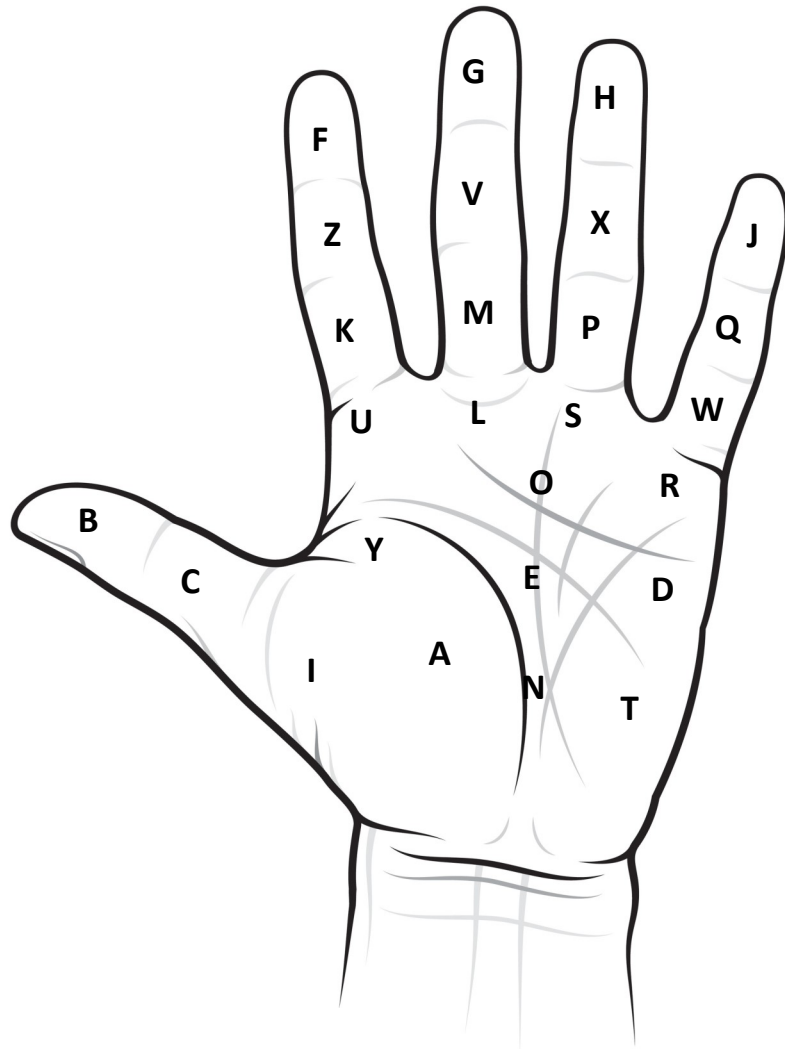

GLOSSARY OF LETTER MEANINGS

A

- ◆ This person has a strong energetic disposition which can stimulate others to activity.
- ◆ They may suffer periods of poor health, but due-care & common sense will overcome this.
- ◆ They sometimes have a tendency to irritability and nervousness, but should control this, or they'll face problems at home and in their finances.
- ◆ They may display timidity or sensitivity at some points in their lives, but this can be overcome by engrossing themselves in some absorbing new activity.
- ◆ Unforeseen events may cause these people to have to move to another place; it may happen more than once in the lifetime.
- ◆ The A person will travel far, and may not return, because they may find a place where they want to remain.
- ◆ This person may possess a fickle temperament. This trait should be controlled, or they'll hurt themselves.
- ◆ The A person *will* attain their ambition, if they apply their energy and skill toward achieving their goal.

B

- ◆ The B person has the ability to manage people, if they apply themselves thoughtfully and honestly to the task.
- ◆ They're very adaptable, and able to handle any problem which presents itself, as long as they don't go to extremes in solving it.
- ◆ The B person needs to *think* before they *act*, because they sometimes tend to be careless. This trait may help defeat their plans, if they aren't sufficiently circumspect.
- ◆ This person can be something of a micro-manager; they're not happy unless they're actively engaged in every project facing them, and up-to-speed on all parts of it.

C

- ◆ This person has an excellent, practical understanding of people, but lengthy discussions will often defeat them in the benefits this trait bestows.
- ◆ They may feel unwilling to reason-out little problems or difficult situations, finding this tedious, but common sense will overcome this reluctance.
- ◆ Their brilliant intelligence will, sooner or later, force them into places and positions of importance.
- ◆ This person may possess impulsive tendencies, but to counter-act this, they must get into the habit of analyzing a situation before jumping into it with both feet.

D

- ◆ The D person has excellent judgement—when they weigh things carefully. They should therefore let nothing discourage them, because success lies ahead.
- ◆ This person has a brusqueness and a forcefulness at times, which can counteract what they're trying to achieve.
- ◆ This person may suffer an inferiority complex. This needs to be overcome with patient and diligent effort.
- ◆ Though they may be utterly-fearless, the D person should stay out of physical fights, as these may well be a source of ill-fortune for them.

E

- ◆ They may have been timid as a child and youth, but will overcome this tendency as they grow older.
- ◆ Their secretiveness and selfishness will endow them with a sort of power. But they may lose the goodwill of family and friends, if they don't modify their ambitions just a bit for the sake of relational harmony.
- ◆ They can achieve their ambitions, if they use both their intelligence and their sense of diplomacy.
- ◆ Their versatility will bring them honors, but they should not become careless, or their carelessness will tarnish those honors a little.
- ◆ This person has a great imagination. They should nurture this, develop it, and use it, but they should not become too irrational with it, or they will not succeed.
- ◆ This person would be surprised if they were to know what people really think of them.

F

- ◆ They're a person of great pride—they should watch-out for a fall, which danger always haunts the proud.
- ◆ This person should not be guided by their superstitions.
- ◆ Their desire for justice will bring them great friendships.
- ◆ This person works well under direction, so they could comfortably join an organization which needs someone with this capability. They would work well in a non-supervisory capacity.
- ◆ This person has artistic talent, but they should not become conceited about it.
- ◆ Their intelligence will take them far, if they diligently pursue the development of their talents.
- ◆ Any tendency to stubbornness must be controlled, or it will draw discouraging situations into their life.

G

- ◆ This person may have a morbid streak in their nature; it's a trait which disturbs the people around them.
- ◆ The G person likes to be alone, and sometimes, it's good for them.
- ◆ This person needs an outdoor occupation and outdoor leisure activities for their happiness.
- ◆ Their indifference will hurt themselves most of all.
- ◆ Reality, not fantasy, is the best path for them, so they should proceed accordingly.
- ◆ They will attain their desire, if they show all due caution in money matters.
- ◆ This person should avoid excesses of every sort, as excesses are particularly harmful to them.
- ◆ Science will carry them through their roughest times in life, so they should count on science as an ally.

H

- ◆ This person should pursue their ideal, for it will bring them much happiness.
- ◆ Music or art will add to their list of achievements, so they should nurture one of these talents.
- ◆ This person should avoid adopting a critical manner, or it will rebound on them and hurt them.
- ◆ This person shouldn't concern themselves with the arts or literature; those aren't their strong-suits.
- ◆ Their talents are numerous, but they should concentrate their efforts on only *one* talent for their pursuit of fame.
- ◆ Bragging will do nothing to further their status, so they should shun this trait. They should let their accomplishments speak for them.

I

- ◆ They should strive to be faithful, for inconstancy on their part will cause them untold anguish.
- ◆ Showing sympathy and humane understanding to others will bring them big dividends.
- ◆ Being too-clever at the wrong moment may rob them of the fulfillment of their physical desires.
- ◆ They should not confuse sensuality with their great love of family.
- ◆ Striving to fulfill their ideals should always be their goal.

J

- ◆ This person will find that their intuition will be very useful to them.
- ◆ An eloquent tongue will only enhance their already-gifted mind.
- ◆ Business schemes are dangerous for this person, so they should be alert for them, and avoid them.
- ◆ If the J person can manage their inventiveness effectively, they could acquire wealth and a high position.

K

- ◆ The K person's desire for independence is fine, but taken to an extreme, it will prove dangerous for them.

- ◆ Theological studies will aid this person greatly, and it will do them some good.
- ◆ Outdoor occupations will prove to be good money-makers for L people.

M

- ◆ Physical comforts and wealth mean everything to the M person, so they often attain these.
- ◆ This person should shun excess in eating, drinking, and other bad habits, as it will do them *no* good.
- ◆ This person holds religion/spirituality in very high regard. This will aid them greatly, and give them peace of mind.

- ◆ The M person should always keep their expenses under control, otherwise it'll destroy them mentally.

N

- ◆ Indecision is this person's worst enemy and chief stumbling-block, and they'll have to conquer this trait alone.

- ◆ Imaginary problems will hound this person, until they make up their mind to stay focused on their more immediate and real problems or interests.

O

- ◆ Misfortune will follow this person, until they stop being so reckless.
- ◆ Dark-imaginings will mar their love-life, if they don't get such thoughts under control.
- ◆ Their devotion will see them through.
- ◆ This person's flirtatious habits will bring them bad luck and disappointment.
- ◆ This person is an idealist in love, so they need to take their time in considering their choice of a spouse.

P

- ◆ If the P person will follow their artistic ability, then they'll have a brilliant career.
- ◆ This person should not follow their artistic abilities as a first-choice of occupation; one of their more-practical abilities will bring them financial rewards.
- ◆ This person will need lots of common sense, to go along with their attractiveness.
- ◆ Literature, music, or art in some form will bring them what they want.
- ◆ A great future can be this person's for the taking, if they concentrate on nurturing and developing their most-obvious talent.

Q

- ◆ This person should look for the scientific approach as their best plan of action in anything they attempt.
- ◆ Their cleverness will take them far in business or industry.
- ◆ This person's ideas may be good, but will need professional management in order to be successful.
- ◆ A general love for humanity will place the Q person in the right profession.
- ◆ This person's schemes often border on genuine risk, and this may get them into trouble.
- ◆ The Q person should look for the best in everything, but at the same time, not get *too* optimistic.

R

- ◆ The R person's persuasive powers can place them in a prominent position.
- ◆ This person has an evasive quality in their nature, and this may cause some people to mark them as a schemer.
- ◆ Their scheming mind and eloquent tongue would cause them to do well in politics.
- ◆ This person will make their money in business.
- ◆ They should select a profession or a white-collar job for their career. Hard physical labor is not for them.
- ◆ If this person ever decides to invent something, they should stay with a practical idea.
- ◆ They may expend too-much energy on too-many projects at once to succeed at any of them. The R person must learn how not to over-extend themselves.
- ◆ Their adventurous spirit will bring many changes into their life.

S

- ◆ They have a great talent, but they shouldn't overrate its value.
- ◆ If the S person pursues their *best* talent, then they will have luck as a bonanza.
- ◆ This person is very gifted, and their gifts will prove entertaining to everyone around them.
- ◆ The S person has a enchanting personality, which will help both themselves and others around them along the road to prosperity.
- ◆ Their versatility and fearlessness will engender a spectacular career for them, but they must also remember to provide for their old-age.
- ◆ This person is aesthetically-inclined, and in spite of their fantasies about unrealistic attainments, they nevertheless must let practicality enter their minds, and carve-out an everyday career for themselves.
- ◆ This person has great vision, but they must not let their vision cause them to lose what they have already attained.
- ◆ This person has great originality, but they must take care not to scatter their energy and talent.

T

- ◆ This person's chief-talent is a great imagination, and if they can harness it effectively, then riches and honors can be theirs.
- ◆ This person can have a restless, nervous disposition, with a streak of petulance, so they need and should seek calming companionship.
- ◆ A change of surroundings often helps mollify this person's restless nature.

- ◆ The T person has a **factual** mind. They need to study history, the hard sciences, or any factually-oriented subject where they can learn facts; not speculation, fantasy, or open-ended questions with no clear answer.
- ◆ They have an impulsive streak. Intensive, devoted study of an art, such as music or dance, or professions, such as medicine or law, would not satisfy them, nor suit their impulsive nature.
- ◆ When their boredom hits, it requires multi-sensory interests in order to sufficiently divert them.
- ◆ This person is a good imitator, and may have a talent for mimicry.
- ◆ They should most-likely be with a group of progressives, as that is more likely to suit their nature.

U

- ◆ The U person takes great pride in their achievements, and rightfully-so, for they are noteworthy and successful.
- ◆ Family and home are this person's pride and joy, and will be, so long as they maintain them.
- ◆ Bragging about their success may end in disappointment for them, so they should shun this habit.
- ◆ Common vulgarity has no place in their life; they should shun it.
- ◆ Their lack of respect may rebound on them. If they can show an occasional willingness to give the other person a boost instead of a knock, they may find their life changing for the better.
- ◆ Their unselfish and charitable qualities will bring them unexpected happiness and prosperity.
- ◆ They should stay with their ideals; for these will bring them great acclaim.
- ◆ This person should beware of any tendency to egotism—it could prove to be their undoing.
- ◆ Their honesty will bring them honors and distinction.
- ◆ Their devoutness is both their present and their future.
- ◆ Intolerance and fanaticism can ruin them, so they should shun these qualities, and any groups which espouse them.
- ◆ Their creativity and adaptability can place them in high-level enterprises.
- ◆ Exaggeration is not for them. They should always stick with the truth.
- ◆ This person should strive to be practical in everything, and to be the stabilizing influence in the family circle, as well as with business and social contacts.

V

- ◆ This person has their **own** ideas about what constitutes the proper set of values. They're usually correct about this too, but they should keep it to themselves.
- ◆ Their interest in land should make them money with real estate.
- ◆ Music, poetry, or both would be an excellent outlet for their introspective, and at-times, melancholy nature.
- ◆ They should apply their mathematical ability to another science, and forget their sensitivity.
- ◆ If this person can overcome their abhorrence of socializing, then they'll have a happy life.
- ◆ This person has no interest in serious studies, but their practicality will nonetheless keep them in a good position.
- ◆ The occult, the paranormal, and the world of superstition hold nothing for them. They should forget any such pursuits, and hold to the ways of whatever constitutes 'normal' living and 'normal' pursuits.

W

- ◆ This person likes having a lot of money, so they should *shun* any tendency to indolence, and put their talent to work.

- ◆ Comedy and humor is their strong-suit, so they should nurture this talent and use it in their profession.
- ◆ This person has excellent business talent, but it'll be useless to them, if they pursue overly-crazy schemes.
- ◆ They should use their originality to their advantage, but at the same time, not be too-impulsive about it.
- ◆ With their sympathetic nature, this person should throw themselves into a service or profession which helps others.
- ◆ Their inherent love of science may be strengthened by their strong capabilities for research.

X

- ◆ This person is very fortunate, that with their wonderful talent, they also have the common sense to direct it effectively.
- ◆ Their artistic talent should be yoked to the merchandising of it in a way which feels most-comfortable to them.
- ◆ This person's interests should be directed toward some specialty in the field of engineering, where they'll find a niche for a particular artistic skill of theirs.
- ◆ This person should try writing only as a hobby at first, until they are satisfied of it's worth it to them. Then, they can decide if they want to try to write professionally or not.

Z

- ◆ The Z person is a calculating idealist. How far will this trait take them? That depends on them.
- ◆ Their pride will not let them concede the point or the victory to others, but their keen ability to appraise a situation correctly will make them successful, nonetheless.
- ◆ Their respect for others may diminish a bit, when they realize their *own* talents and abilities exceed those of others.
- ◆ They should re-direct any tendency to personal vanity onto their home and surroundings. Nothing can harm *those*.
- ◆ Whatever great business or promising enterprise they undertake, they are cautioned not to brag about it. If they can avoid complacency while maintaining their ideals, then they will attain their goals.
