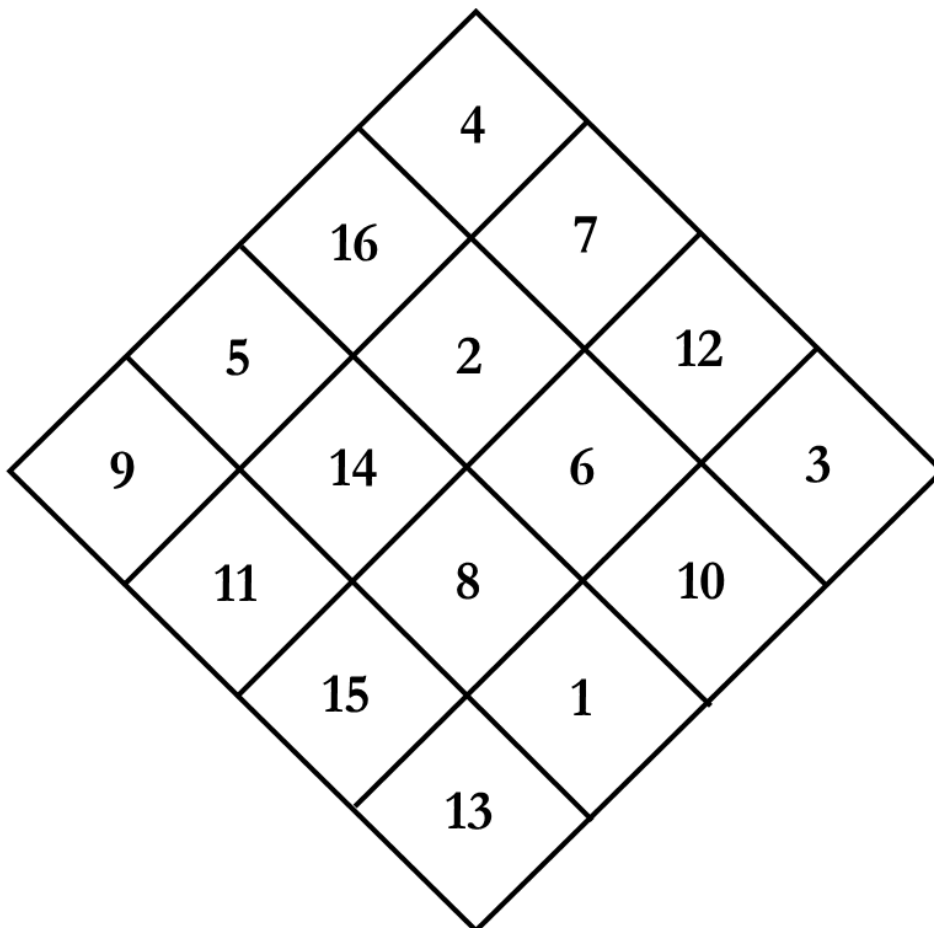


# TABLET OF THE DIAMOND



*For questions concerning matters of the mind, thought, and  
decision-making.*

*To be consulted no more than once every 33 days.*

## **RULES:**

The inquirer sits, with eyes closed and pointer aimed down at the diagram, while another participant turns the diagram around three times under the pointer tip. Eyes still closed, the inquirer points to whatever part of the diagram they feel impelled-to.

If the inquirer fails to land anywhere on the diagram on the first try, they may try just once more. If this attempt fails, they must wait another 29 hours before trying again. If the inquirer does obtain an answer on either their first or second attempt, they should wait another 33 days before consulting it again. The folklore connected with this tablet dictates that to consult it any sooner than 33 days will 'disturb its magical powers.'
